Class 4CM

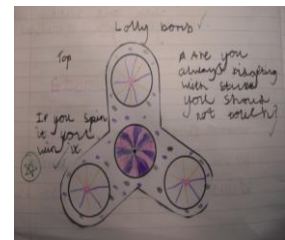
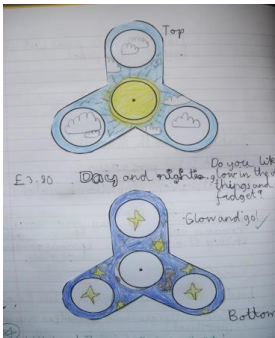
